2. Last month some of us received bogus emails that appeared to come from our Sports Car Club. The likely cause was due to malware or virus software that has infected one of our computers.

Terry Rooney made a presentation at our meeting on August 1, 2016 about protecting all your computers from malware. We thought it is important to let everyone know about Malwarebytes, found at www.malwarebytes.com. Terry recommends that everyone download this program and run it every two weeks. It will really help to remove harmful software that may have infected your computers.

Malwarebytes runs on both Windows and Mac computers. Mac malware is much less prevalent than on Windows, but does exist.

Malwarebytes does NOT replace your normal anti-virus program like Avast, Norton, McAfee, etc. However, no anti-virus program is 100% effective. Malwarebytes is particularly good, and may find bad stuff that other programs do not. It will not interfere with your normal anti-virus program.

Malwarebytes is available free. Each time the user wants a scan done they must start the free version. You can buy the Premium version for Windows for \$20 (\$35 for 2 years), which can be installed on two computers and will run automatically.

The Windows version will usually take about 30 or 40 minutes to run the first time. You may find no PUP's (Potentially Unwanted Programs) or you may find hundreds (1800 is the record for computers Terry has worked on). Please give this a try.
