Tour Events: Wood McCann

Wood reviewed the suggested tours and updates for the next publication of the 2023 Suggested tour list. Several members offered their current thinking of additionally proposed tour. The trip list will be sent to full membership through the club 's email account by week's end.

The first one on February 28 is to Red Hawk Casino for a buffet and go cart racing. The leader, Tom Breckon, encouraged those interested to sign up for go-carting in the indoor track. He said 14 cars have signed up so far.

The second trip, April 21, is the Sausage run with lunch at Teresa's Restaurant in Jackson.

On June 13-14, Tom Breckon will lead a tour to the Vikingsholm Castle, on the west shore of Lake Tahoe. The parking lot will only hold 15 cars. If you want to go, you can email Tom to get a trip flyer and to make sure there is room on the tour before making your hotel reservation.

Tom described the Third Thursday rides. They are similar to Impromptu Rides, but intended to offer a slightly more aggressive driving experience. More aggressive does not mean outside the traffic laws. It means the leaders may not slow down for followers to catch up. Instead they will meet at the next planned stop. Often these are held on the third Thursday of a month.

We are currently looking for someone to organize our Third Thursday rides. As in all things, it generally takes someone to step up, lead a few rides, and encourage others to lead them as well. These are shorter rides with very little planning required. If you are interested in being our Third Thursday honcho, please contact Tom.

Steve Beede described a possible tour to Lake Almanor with a stop at Mt. Lassen up through Graeagle. The date to be decided. He also asked if anyone was interested in going to Virginia City, Nevada to see the Ostrich and Camel Races which takes place September 8. Members showed interest in both trips.

Chuck Schmidt suggested going to Caesar's Palace, staying overnight at Harrah's in South Lake Tahoe. We would drive through Shenandoah Valley and Carson Pass.

Sandy Kline said she and Edy Ternullo would like to lead a tour to Swabbies on the River. She also mentioned going to Fair Oaks Theater.

Tom mentioned she or anyone can contact Wood with a tour suggestion. Wood offered to help leaders with their paperwork. Each tour should include a list of participants with phone numbers. Wood said he has a great program to create a participant list. Trip participants like to associate people with their cars, and may need to contact each other by cell phone.

We had a wonderful response at the January meeting by many members willing to lead trips this year. And, of course, we are always looking for new trip ideas from all the members, especially new members who may have a favorite place to go that the club hasn't already been to.
