Welcome to Members and Guests

President's Report: Tom Breckon

This has been a very successful year. We had lots of Tours and Socials this year, and lots of participation. Wood and Linda will recap our activities for the year.

Ernie will conduct a vote tonight for the four elected members of the Board for next year. You may have already voted by email, but some will vote in person tonight.

The Board recently met and there will be some changes to our process for renewing memberships and paying dues. Vic will present that tonight, and an email will go out to the whole club as well.

The Board decided to ask for volunteers to provide cookies and water, or maybe other surprises, for our after-meeting socials. Linda will talk about that tonight.

Vic Kremesec:

Vic reported there were 35 households and 55 members at the meeting.

Vic described the new process for members to renew their annual membership and pay dues. We were advised that the liability release forms we have on file can become unenforceable after too many years have gone by. So, we will be asking all members to fill out new membership and release forms and submit along with their checks.

Also, there is a new section on the form for members to indicate their willingness to actively participate in the leadership of the club. We need to start grooming some potential future Board members if the club is to continue long into the future.

Carol gave the Current financial report. We have a beginning balance of \$1,960.85 and after deposits and disbursements, we have a balance of \$1,845.85.

Social Events: Linda Snyder

After saying she had a great time this year, she thanked Ron and Elly for making all the flyers for the social events.

Linda Reported that we that we had 6 socials this year, 7 including the Christmas party. Beginning with the Mardi Gras on February 17 there were 64 members. On April 8th, we had the Murder Mystery dinner at Pescatore Winery, there were too many people, and it was very crowded. In July, 50 people attended a dinner at the Cliff house. Twenty-seven cars went on the "Brews and Cruise". At the Luau 40 attended at the Pescatore Winery where Kathy's hula dancers entertained for a good time. At the Country and Western dance, 54 attended on October 26. The upcoming Christmas Party on December 14th at Catta Verdera will have a limit of 104 members. Linda also mentioned we have booked the 2024 Christmas party for December 12th at Catta Verdera.

Linda Proposed we start asking for volunteers to serve baked cookies and water, or anything you like such as celebrating an event with a cake, for the social time after our meetings next year. She said it would be a nice way to get members involved each meeting. The volunteer may request reimbursement up to \$30 by giving our treasurer a receipt.

Liaison/Historian: Jeanne Cervantes

Jeanne reported that she has contracted for the presentation hall for 2024. The first meeting will be January 8th at 6:30, the second Monday of January. The First Monday of September is Labor Day, so we will meet on September 9th. When she tried to book the Placer room for our cookies after the meeting, she questioned why the charge was different than \$42.50 for some days. She will meet to discuss this but said the charge will be about \$500 for the year.

Tom said in the past we had tail-gate parties, but it was too cold, too hot or possibly raining so the Board decided indoors would be a better way to socialize after the meeting.

Tour Events: Wood McCann

Wood recapped our year, by saying we had 16 tours, and he was happy to help anyone with the planning of the tour. Wood posted all the 16 rides on the big screen for our review. He described the "Impromptu" tour as people just show up and drive. We had two of those this year. It is a very easy way to start leading tours. What a successful year we had!

Wood called on Jeanne to talk about her tour and picnic on Wednesday, November 8th to Thundering Herd Ranch. She said we will meet at Orchard Creek at 9:45 am, leave at 10 am and arrive at about 11 am. They have many olive oils, vinegars, and mandarins and the owner will demo various products. Bring your own picnic which will be held outdoors at picnic tables. The limit is 15 cars.

Wood talked about how the English colony was started by his Great Grandfather among others. They were recruited from England to the area to start orchards. The manager showed Wood where the English Colony clubhouse is located. He was surprised to see it looked like an old photo of his Great Grandfather by that clubhouse.
