Ron reported last month on a significant cost increase by the company that hosts our website. Ron will give us an update tonight.

The service company that was hosting our website has been sold. The new company is more than doubling our cost of service (\$334 to \$738 for 3 years). The company is also withdrawing technical support for the particular technology that we use. The technical and financial implications to our budget are being assessed. We need to make a decision about which company will host our website in the future, and whether or not we might consider changing technologies. Our deadline on this is March 29th when our current contract is up.
