

Over Night Tour of Glen Ellen, Petaluma, Bodega Bay and Armstrong Redwood Reserve

Starting on June 4th we will be leaving from the Wave Parking Area at 8:00 A.M.

Traveling the back roads to make our first stop in Winters for a Coffee/Restroom break, continuing on to some fun winding roads that take us to Glen Ellen. We will have a little over an hour to tour the Jack London restored Cottage, where he wrote and learn about London's world-wide adventures at the House of Happy Walls Museum. Then we will have lunch at the historic Wolf House Hotel. After lunch we will go to Benziger Winery. Here we will have a 45 minute tram tour, including a visit to a wine cave. At the end of the tour we will have a special tasting of award winning wines. The next stop is to visit the Petaluma Co-Op Creamery; this local landmark has been in existence since 1913 as a co-op with 33 farmers producing bulk cheese. One of their biggest clients is Chipotle Mexican Grills. They produce approximately one million pounds of cheese a month. After that we will continue to the Bodega Coast Inn, where you can rest or walk before dinner. At approximately 6:15 P.M. we will leave for a 6:30 P.M. dinner at Stormy's in Bloomfield. Stormy's is one of the oldest roadhouses in the west, established in 1854. It has a reputation for delicious food and beverages.

The next day we will return home by way of seeing some of the beautiful Pacific Coast and stopping at Armstrong Redwood State Reserve, known as the Coast Redwoods. These Coast Redwoods are considered temperate rainforest, because they need wet and mild climates. The Pioneer Nature Trail is a little over a mile and is mostly flat and level. This Reserve is in Guerneville.

There are 15 Rooms being held at the Bodega Coast Inn, 707-875-2217 (under LH Sports Car Group). All rooms have a view of Bodega Bay. With our group discount, King Beds are \$169.00; Queen Beds are \$159.00. Free breakfast is available the next morning.
