This three day two-night trip will travel through some of the best scenic roads in California. We will leave OC and travel to Upper Lake for a gourmet lunch at the Blue Wing. Along the way we will take a break at Granzella's in Williams.

Upon arrival in Ferndale we will check in at the California Redwoods Boutique Hotel, *The Victorian Inn* for a two-night stay. (If we fill this trip we will be the only guests in the hotel.) We will dine that night, probably at the *Ivanhoe Restaurant and Saloon*.

On Wednesday we will drive to the town on Trinidad, about 45 miles north along the coast. Trinidad is noted for its spectacular coastline with ten public beaches and offshore rocks, and is part of the California Coastal National Monument. In the afternoon you will have time on your own to explore the Lost Coast or to wander about Ferndale and soak in its Victorian spirit.

Wednesday evening we will dine at the Victorian Inn with a fixed price menu developed for the LHSCG. On Thursday you can travel home with the group or stay on a day or two to explore on your own.
