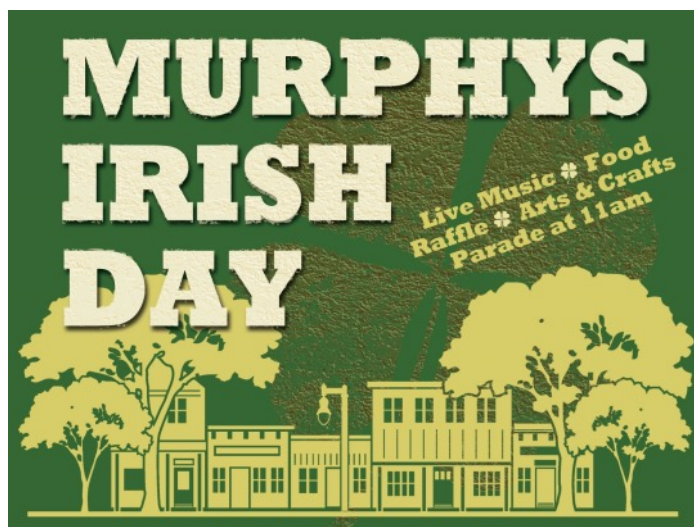

Agenda:

Day 1: Thursday, March 15th - Drive from SCLH through the picturesque and winding hills of Highway 49 from Auburn towards Murphy's. Spend the afternoon exploring **Columbia State Historic Park**, a living gold rush town featuring the largest single collection of existing gold rush-era structures in the state. After lunch at the Columbia House Restaurant, we'll drive to Murphy's and check in at Murphy's Suites Hotel. We'll have a Pizza Party and Social evening in the Common Room. BYOB.

Day 2: Friday, March 16th - Breakfast at the Suites or on your own then a morning ride to **Ironstone Vineyard**. Tour the Vineyard and Grounds as well as the famous Heritage Museum with the largest Crystalline Gold Leaf specimen in the world. Enjoy wine-tasting, and lunch at the Gold Leaf Deli. After lunch we'll head into Murphy's for a guided tour of the famous town and then you're on your own to shop, or rest. At 5:00 pm we'll have **Dinner in the Ballroom of the Historic Murphy's Hotel**.

Day 3: Saturday, March 17th - Murphy's Irish Day - Each year, Murphy's shuts down Main Street to celebrate like only the Irish can. The Parade starts at 11 am. Stay to eat, taste and shop the Irish Day booths, local tasting rooms and stores of Murphy's, buy a raffle ticket for a chance to win a famous trip to Ireland, enjoy music, dancing and Celtic entertainment on their two stages, bagpipers and jugglers on the street. You're on your own for the afternoon. We'll head home at around 4:00pm.
