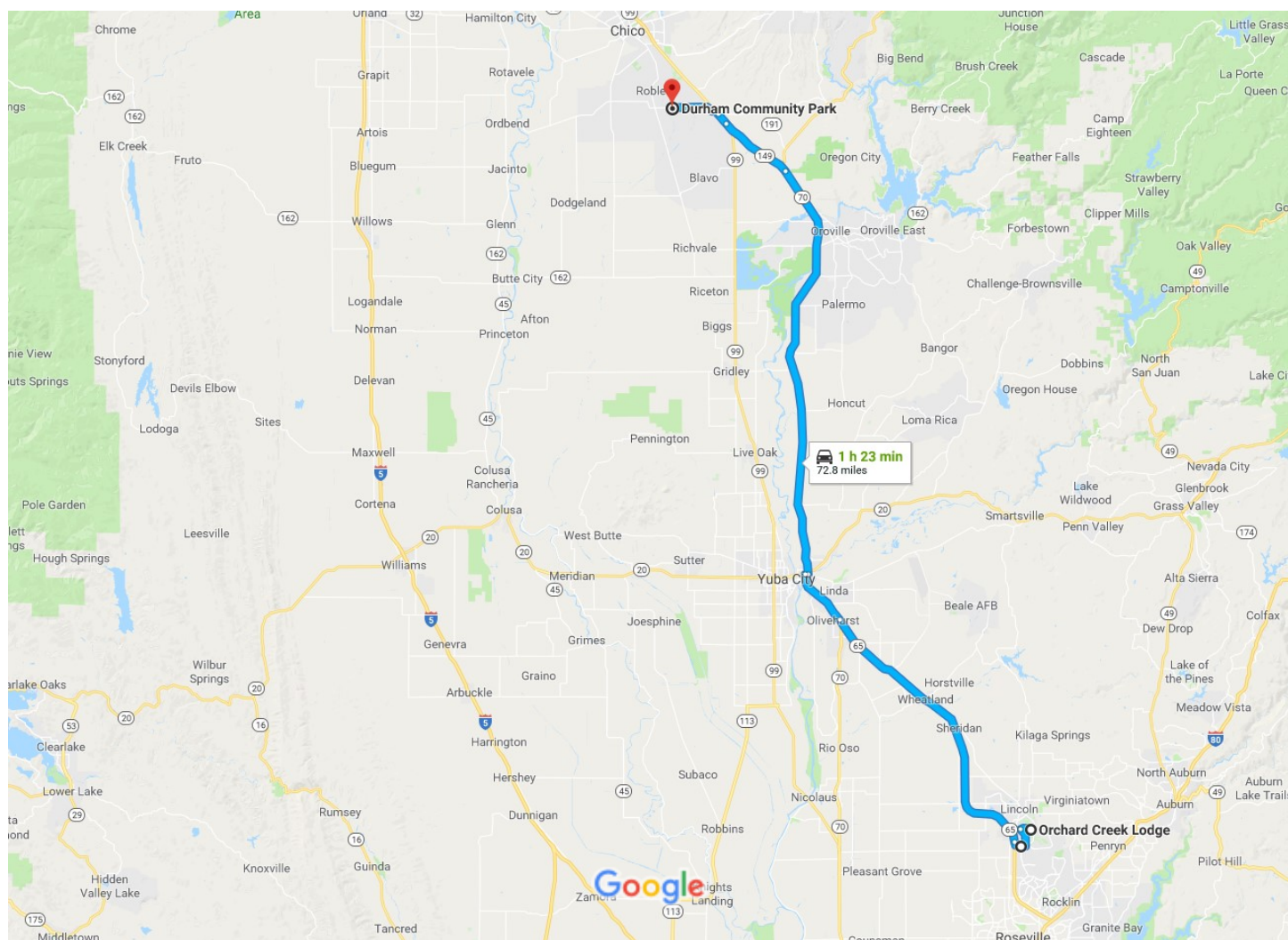
Directions to the Durham Harvest Festival in Durham, CA, Travel Time ~1.5 hr.

- 1) Depart Orchard Creek parking lot at 8: 00 am sharp!
- 2) Exit LEFT on Del Web Blvd. TURN LEFT onto Joiner Parkway, TURN right onto Twelve Bridges.
- 3) Merge onto Hwy. 65 North.
- 4) Continue on HWY 65 into Marysville. Turn RIGHT onto Hwy 70, stay in the left lane proceeding around the lake traveling towards Oroville.
- 5) Stay on Hwy 70 thru Oroville.
- 6) North of Oroville the Hwy will "V" Stay on the LEFT, 149 Hwy to Chico. In a short distance, Hwy 149 will blend into Hwy 99 North toward Chico.
- 7) Durham exit is 376 before Chico. Turn LEFT and go 4 miles to Durham!
