

MONTE VISTA INN DUTCH FLAT, DINNER RUN

Dutch Flat is approximately 30 miles above Auburn Ca. on I 80. We will leave from Orchard Creek Lodge at 2 o'clock driving along the back roads for dinner at Monte Vista Inn.

(Directions will be made available prior to leaving for the outing.)

Dutch Flat is a California Historical Landmark. It was an important stopping point on the stagecoach line. The original idea for what would become the Central Pacific Railroad was born in Dutch Flat in 1959. Monte Vista Inn is an Historical building family owned since 1972 offering great atmosphere, food, and service. On any given day you will be greeted by John and Abby the owners or one of their family members. Monte Vista Inn is a Hidden Jewel.

DINNER MENU

1. PRIME RIB – gently seasoned Certified Angus Beef prime rib, slow roasted, creamed horseradish.
2. CHICKEN PICCATA – breast of chicken, pan seared with a lemon, caper and white wine “piccata” sauce.
3. FRESH ATLANTIC SALMON – extremely fresh fillet grilled over coals, topped with a tropical pineapple salsa.

This menu includes freshly baked bread, salad with choice of dressing, steamed garden vegetables and appropriate starch. Coffee, dessert.

The fare for this menu is \$50.00 per person including tax and tip.
