

Lincoln Fire Department's 7th Annual Turkey Drive



On Thursday, November 19th, our Sports Car Club will participate in the Lincoln Fire Department's Annual Turkey Drive. We will meet in our usual place outside the Orchard Creek Lodge gym for a prompt 2:30 p.m. departure to the fire station. We'll be driving to Lincoln Fire Station #34 at 126 Joiner Parkway where we will donate our frozen turkeys.

This year, especially, with the Covid-19 pandemic forcing many of our local families to be separated from their sources of income, we have an urgent need for food and other assistance in our community. All of the frozen turkeys that we bring to the fire station will be donated to the Salt Mine and then to other local charities. The fire station can store up to 800 frozen turkeys.

We've been isolated from our club and our friends this year due to the Covid-19 virus, and this will be an opportunity to say hello to some of them. We'll observe safety recommendations regarding social distancing and wearing of masks, as appropriate. And, if you wish, the attendees at the fire station will extract your frozen turkey from your trunk without you getting out of your car.
