Important times:

- 8:00am** – Tuesday, arrive at our OC usual assembly spot. At OC, we will line up in a specific order corresponding to the group's position number that has been assigned by the parade organizer. Bring some tape to attach your individual car position number allowing the parade announcer to ID your vehicle details.
- 8:15am** - Departure. The parade maps are somewhat complex this year, so it will be important that you stay "tight" when leaving OC. Please, use your walkies [on Channel 6.1] to alert Steve if you get trapped at a stop. Simplified directions to the **parade staging area** will be provided later if you get delayed.
- 8:30am** - We must be settled in assigned number order at the parade staging area.
- 9:00am** – Parade begins. Parade Block Captains will direct us when to move into parade insertion. Most likely, we will be near the end of the parade line.

Notes:

1. The parade organizers need an accurate Car Club participation count no later than **June 20**. The Club will pay a modest fee for our group's participation. There is no car number limitation. **Contact Steve at his email on the LHSCG Roster for a spot.**
2. From the time you leave OC in specific car order, to the end of the parade, we estimate the duration at about 2.5 hours.
3. If you will have decorations for your car, there will be enough time to put them in place at the parade's staging area.
