

## Day Trip

# CA Computer History Museum in Mountain View Saturday, March 12

The newly remodeled and enlarged Computer History Museum traces the history of computing from the abacus to the present day. Exhibits include the Babbage Engine (a mechanical computer - demo at 1 pm), internet history from 1962, silicone chips, computer storage, and many more. Overview of the day trip:

Meet at Orchard Creek Lodge at 7:45AM and leave at 8:00AM.

Stop at Starbucks in Stockton for coffee and arrive about 11:00 am at the Museum. We will primarily be travelling the interstate.

Admission to the museum is \$12 for seniors; \$15 for youngsters. There is a café at the museum for lunch (typical menu will be on the website); there are many places to eat within a short distance of the Museum – you may leave and return to the Museum throughout the day.

We will leave the Museum about 3:00 pm and head to the Buckhorn Restaurant in Winters for dinner (reservations at 5:30 pm); Virgil (our co-leader) has picked out some back roads. There will be a rest stop at Starbucks in Pleasant Hill.

This is the first light after the exit. Rather than a u-turn, make a left and there is an entrance to the back of Starbucks on Feather River Drive.







The entrance to the Museum is immediately to your right or you can make the right at Pear. There is parking along the far side of the Museum and restaurants are across the street and along Shoreline Blvd.



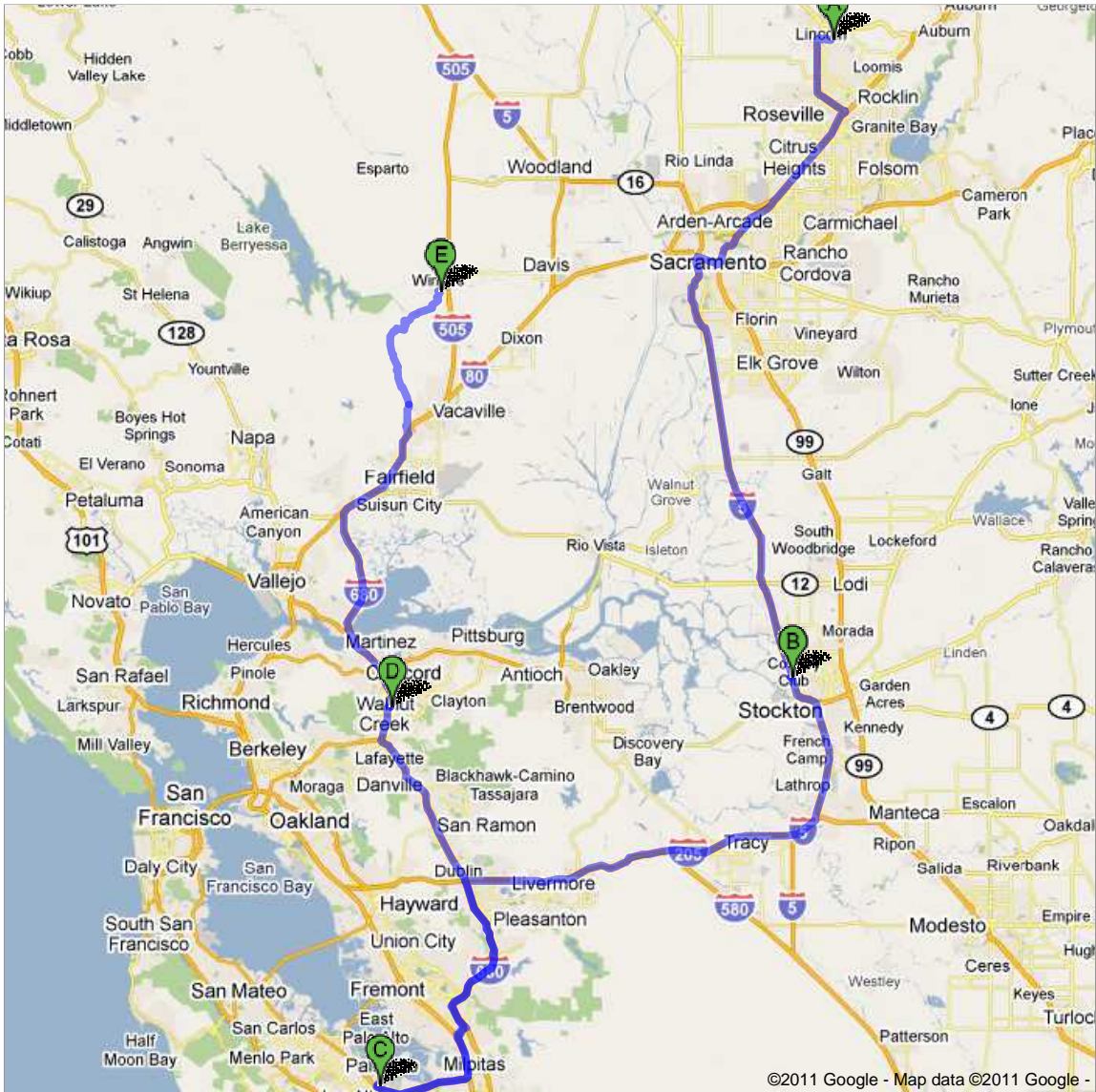

The Story of the First Computer Pioneer

Charles Babbage designed the first automatic computing engines but failed to build them. Now, 153 years after it was designed, Difference Engine No. 2, built faithfully to the original drawings, is here at the Computer History Museum. Discover the wonder of a future already passed. Daily tours and demonstrations are available.



Visible Storage:  
Highlights from the Museum's Collection

Learn about the history of computing and experience over 600 unique artifacts, from rare slide rules and mechanical calculators to the earliest one-of-kind computers, vintage PCs, historical firsts and exotic supercomputers. Both docent led and self-guided tours are available.

The Computer History Museum holds events year-round dedicated to celebrating computer history. The Museum offers a highly respected speaker series with scholarly historical perspectives by and about the computing

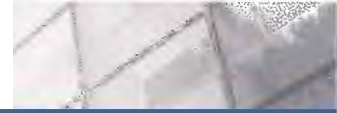

Admission to the Museum gives our visitors a variety of exhibitions to explore. In addition to our landmark 25,000 square foot exhibition *Revolution: The First 2000 Years of Computing*, visitors can also see *Mastering the Game: A History of Computer Chess*, the *POP-1*, where visitors can play one of the earliest video games, *Space Wars!*, and the *8abbage Difference Engine #2*, a Victorian-era computer with 8,000 parts, weighing five tons and measuring 11 feet in length.
