CA Computer History Museum in Mountain View Saturday, March 12

The newly remodeled and enlarged Computer History Museum traces the history of computing from the abacus to the present day. Exhibits include the Babbage Engine (a mechanical computer - demo at 1 pm), internet history from 1962, silicone chips, computer storage, and many more. Overview of the day trip:

Meet at Orchard Creek Lodge at 7:45AM and leave at 8:00AM.

Stop at Starbucks in Stockton for coffee and arrive about 11:00 am at the Museum. We will primarily be travelling the interstate.


