Deadline for Treasure Hunt arrival will be:

**12:30 PM (Lunch is 1:00 to 2:00 PM)
Points gained (+) for being early
Points lost (-) for being late**

When you receive your Treasure Hunt info, you may want to take some time to study the items to plan your route to the restaurant as not every item/task can be found in time to make it to the 12:30 PM deadline required at the restaurant. Choose where to go and what to find carefully!

From time to time before the “Hunt” begins, hints will be provided. Save these hints!

 - **Arrival time is determined only when the Official Treasure Hunt Collection Sheet is received and marked by either the Tour Leaders or Co-Leaders (not based on arrival time to parking lot)**
 - **Early arrivals before 12:30 PM deadline will gain points (+)**
 - **Late arrivals after 12:30 PM deadline will lose points (-)**
 - **Points are allowed for one item per “Section Item” unless in Red Ink – where points are then allowed once per indicated item (explained in Parking lot)**
- **Should participants turn in Official Treasure Hunt Collection Sheets with the same score, arrival times marked on their sheets will be used to break ties**
