In the morning we will drive south on Hwy 395 to Milford. From there we will work our way through the Sierras on some back roads to Hwy. 49 and Downieville where we will have lunch. After lunch we will continue down Hwy. 49 to Grass Valley for a break before continuing on to Lincoln. Don't forget your Senior National Park Pass. Being in the backcountry I don't anticipate any costly lodging or meals.
