Safari West Tour

Stay overnight in a deluxe tent-cabin at a special group rate of \$170 (usually \$265), with breakfast included. There is onsite dining at the Savannah Grill, with full bar, music and a patio with fire pit. We plan to have marshmallow roasting, and s'mores after dinner. Special protected parking is being provided for our sports cars. See over 100 different animal species as a tour guide escorts you on a 2-hour jeep safari, and a 45 minute guided walk through the aviary (\$68). Following the safari, there is time to freshen up before having appetizers at 6:30 and barbeque buffet dinner at 7:00 p.m. (\$29).



Thirty tent-cabins are being held for our club through April 30; after that, unreserved cabins will be released to the public. Accommodations have either king bed or two doubles. All have separate bathrooms with hot shower. The outside porch has a great view of the beautiful surroundings, and you can see a small lake, green vistas and some of the animals. Each cabin has a cooler on the porch, filled with ice to keep your drinks and snacks cold.

This ride will include a rest stop in Napa, lunch at V'Sattui Winery in St. Helena, and on the way back we'll stop for lunch at a local winery or restaurant.
